

Grace Medical Home Overview

Grace Medical Home is a Christ-centered, comprehensive medical practice for the low-income, uninsured in Central Florida. Staffed by a clinical team including three full-time physicians, four full-time mid-levels, three-part time nurse practitioners, a Registered Nurse, 7 MAs, 1 pharmacy tech, 1 registered dietician, 1 LCSW and 1 Dental Assistant, 3 care coordination staff, 3 front-desk, and hundreds of clinical volunteers, this medical practice offers wholistic care with 28 medical subspecialty clinics to the most marginalized in our community. We are a 501(c)3 with strong community support.

Our mission is to "See to it that no one misses the Grace of God" (Hebrews 12:15) by sharing the love of Christ through excellent health care to those in our community who need it the most. We value up close relationships, justice, dignity and radical respect. We embrace the entire person and seek to break down barriers that prevent wholeness and healing. We humbly recognize our own poverty and how that connects us to the brokenness of our patients. We long to be a part of God's restorative work and cling to the promise that God redeems all things and makes them new.

- Helps guide clinical team in practicing the highest standard of patient care including delegating tasks to to coordinate care in accordance to the patient's needs and GMH team members' capabilities and qualifications.
- Respects diversity by working creatively and collaboratively to build respectful relationships with staff, volunteers and patients to deliver services consistent with our mission, vision and values.
- Helps point others to a relationship with Jesus Christ and represents the ministry of GMH in the community with integrity.
